

Four of family sentenced to life term for killing groundnut seller

VADODARA: Four persons of a family were sentenced to rigorous life imprisonment for killing a groundnut seller in Gajrawadi area in March last year.

The court of principal district judge Dr A C Joshi convicted Raju alias Balkrishna Pawar, his two sons Vishal alias Langdo and Dhaval and his nephew Akshay Borade on Thursday for killing Vicky Kanojija over a past rift.

The four had attacked Kanojija on the night of March 26 last year when he was playing cricket with his friends. They attacked with him with swords, chopped his three fingers and stabbed him in public view. Kanojija suffered 23 stab wounds and four severe internal injuries and died before reaching the hospital.

Kanojija's friend Jaydeep Thakkar, who was also attacked, had registered an FIR at Panigate police station.

The attackers were arrested later and tried in the sessions court here. Additional public prosecutor K P Chavan submitted several documentary evidences and 16 witnesses were examined. The arguments made by Chavan and evidences were upheld by the court for their conviction. The court concluded that all four of them had premeditated or pre-planned the action of inflicting forceful blows on Kanojija's head, neck and abdomen which resulted in his death.

"The case on hand is not of one where one could say that the accused had lost their sense in the heat of passion. On the contrary it was a pre-planned act which was very well articulated by all of them and thereby the motive and intention of all is clearly proved," the court stated in the judgement.

Wish PV Sindhu on winning maiden World Badminton Championships gold "This is my answer to the people who have asked me questions over and over. I just wanted to answer with my racket and with this win - that's all," Sindhu was quoted as saying by the Badminton World Federation's (BWF) official website after her crushing win over Okuhara.

"I felt really bad after the first World Championships final and last year I was angry, I was sad. I went through all my emotions, asking 'Sindhu, why can't you get this one match?' but today came and I told myself to play my game and not worry - and it worked out," she added. Sindhu The 24-year-old from Hyderabad became the first Indian to achieve the feat by thrashing familiar rival Nozomi Okuhara of Japan 21-7, 21-7 in one of the most lop-sided finals ever.
